ABOUT THE CONFERENCE



During the last three decades we are witnessing a radical change as the medical information systems have been integrated in order to address the core of medicine, including patient care in ambulatory and in-patient setting, computer assisted diagnosis and treatment, telemedicine, and home care. This will continue in the years to come. Our previous meetings and collaboration with medical centers have shown a requirement for a platform, that can integrate researches and technologists whose afford focuses on bridging the gap between modern information technologies and clinical medicine.
